Sunday, October 4th 2009 (2:00 PM)

Gary Christen, "The New Astrology." As astrologers, we have seen many schools of thought pass through our field like cars on the highway. Some have had great use and have changed our techniques and viewpoints. Others have just passed by either too slowly or sped by without being fully appreciated. The current resurgence of interest in astrology's past is leading to a bounty of positive change for astrology's future.

Gary will describe the vital techniques and viewpoints that are being realized from astrology's reexamination – ideas that will shape the astrology of the future. (While known as a Uranian astrologer, Gary will be treating this specialty as only a contributing factor in astrology's overall evolution.) Gary sees astrology as one of the conceptual keys that will usher in a whole new human paradigm, and believes that the dawn of the real New Age is now within sight. Astrology should play a vital role in this new model, but it must first undergo a major evolution. Come see where we are heading and learn about the new possibilities before us.

(Gary Christen is a well-known practitioner of Uranian Astrology, which he has evolved into modern Symmetrical Astrology. An astrologer since his teens, he is the first person in modern times awarded an accredited B.A. degree in Astrology (Livingston College, Rutgers University, 1974. An international lecturer, Gary has been teaching since the early seventies. Saturday, October 3rd, 2009 1:00-5:00 PM
Gary Christen, The Times We Live In

We certainly live in Interesting Times, and the current planetary combinations confirm that this is a critical period in human history. It's all happening now: economic upheavals, large-scale social transformation, and climate and earth changes.

For many years, Gary presented annual Solstice talks in which he predicted upcoming world events for the year, and also gave personal readings based on the winter solstice chart. In this workshop, Gary will give an insider's view of the techniques he uses to develop these predictions from solstice and other ingress charts. (While there will be no personal readings during this workshop, students will learn how to do such predictions for themselves.) He will also show techniques from Symmetrical Astrology on the current and coming combinations as well as how he integrates dynamic material for mundane forecasting.

Gary will also discuss rare upcoming planetary patterns – combinations that do not happen often in human history, let alone a lifetime. We should have lots of fun and get Gary's perspective on the times.

Bill Meridian, Eclipses: Their Rules and Paths

In this workshop, Bill will describe the eclipse rules of Charles Jayne and L. Edward Johndro. This powerful set of techniques allows one to accurately judge the effects of an eclipse, and to determine the timing of these effects by both transits and progressions. Bill will also describe how you determine your "birth eclipse," and how to interpret your personal eclipse path. In addition, Bill will discuss the use of eclipses and shadows in mundane astrology.

(Bill Meridian became interested in the stock market in 1966. After obtaining his BS and MBA degrees in 1972, he began to study cycles. This led to the study of astrology in October of that year. He was heavily influenced by Charles Jayne, his teacher, and by the Hamburg School of astrology. Bill began on Wall Street as a fundamental analyst utilizing horoscopes of incorporation. He then developed the concept of the horoscope of first trade. Bill has been involved in the design of numerous successful market analysis programs that integrate the use of planetary cycles.

He has worked both the buy and sell side of Wall Street, most recently spending 14 years in the Middle East as a fund manager and strategist. He currently operates his own business from his home in Europe. Bill spends most of his time in Vienna, London, Tokyo, and Abu Dhabi. Jeri London, Karmic Astrology and Spirituality

In this workshop we will examine the traditional definition of karma as well as expanded and current views. In the process of human evolution we learn spiritual lessons. Examining karmic points of the astrological chart in conjunction with the 12 signs can tell us much about what we came into this life to learn or master. Within our human experience we become aware of what is toxic and depleting in our lives—the shadow side of ourselves. As evolutionary beings we can choose to shift our consciousness from a state of darkness or imbalance to an energy field which is healing, restoring, and of the light. Awareness augments the raising of our vibrational frequency. Spiritual laws and spiritual practices will be discussed in reference to the karmic points and the 12 signs as a means of re-orienting our energy field from imbalance to balance. Part of this workshop will include viewing charts of well known figures, both past and present.
